Contemplative Prayer Form

Trinity Sunday - Year A



Note: This is for individual or small group use. It is intended to be a form of contemplative "Lectio Divina" based on the scripture readings for the week and the themes of the liturgical season. Repetition, silence, and intercession are utilized to allow space for focus over a short or long period of time. It may be helpful to use your fingers to count the number of scripture phrases you utter during the times of repetition. The Scripture prayer section is structured for easy use with <u>Anglican Prayer Beads</u> for those who might find a tactile expression to be helpful (# = Cross O = Invitatory bead O = Cruciform bead O = Weeks bead).

Scripture Reading: Matthew 28:16-20 (NIV)

Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some doubted. Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."
